Tour Hosts

1. Pioneers in the Park

See demonstrations of pioneer crafts and skills, visit the historical encampment, enjoy live music and entertainment, try your hand at pioneer games and activities, and shop from local crafters.



2. Northern Ohio Railway Museum

Visit this unique museum to see streetcars, interurban, and railroad equipment from Northern Ohio dating from 1895 to 1970. The tour includes a visit to the museum store, and streetcar rides will be offered (weather permitting).

3. Morning Star Farms

Enjoy the open country landscape where faith, family, and nature connect, and the focus is on honoring the youth of America. Visit with a variety of youth groups, stroll through the horse stables, and enjoy family-friendly crafts and activities.

4. Lodi Library

Library staff eagerly awaits your visit and will have local history displays and slide show, local artist art show, make-n-take crafts, kid's games, and Friends of the Library used book sale.



5. Lodi Harrisville Historical Society

Tour the Waite-Harris House, the circa 1890 home of Dr. James and Rachel Waite, descendants of Lodi founder Joseph Harris. The home is bedecked in late-Victorian décor, and items from Lodi High School will be on display. Historical society items will be for sale.

6. Lodi Railroad Museum

A train depot dating to 1882 and caboose from 1949 await your visit. A collection of railroad artifacts and memorabilia will be on display, and small railroad items will be available for purchase.

7. Mack's Food Center

Visit this old-fashioned meat market and grocery store, established in 1947, to see the butchering process and how jerky, smokies, and sausages are made. Tour the jerky plant, and sample some of the tasty products. Grocery items will be available for purchase.

8. Richman Farms

The Indoe family welcomes you to its 700-acre farm. Learn about a variety of farm crops, and visit the state-of-the-art cow milking barn that replaced the one destroyed by a tornado in 2007. Ice cream will be available from the Lodi Ruritan Club.



9. Pine Crest Farm



Stroll through the barnyard and stables, enjoy a hayride to pick your own pumpkin, and see farm equipment displays at the Kormos family farm. Other fun, family-friendly activities include: corn and hay mazes, haunted house, farm train, and petting zoo. The farm market features fresh produce, fall decorations, food, and drinks for sale.

10. Circle B Stables



Visit this turn of the century horse farm and training facility to learn about horse care, training, and the discipline of "reining." Enjoy a stroll through the original barn, carriage house, and the bunk house that hosts horse camp activities.





Points of Interest



A. Killbuck Lakes Park – *NO ORGANIZED ACTIVITIES* -This Medina County Park District site opened in 2015 and features opportunities for fishing, hiking, canoeing, kayaking, and wildlife observation.  

B. Sign Our Streams program - *DRIVE BY ONLY* - Adopt a stream or river crossing to encourage stewardship of our waterways. Contact Medina County Soil and Water Conservation District for more information.

C. First Congregation Church - This historic place of worship dates back to 1817. Inside is a beautiful memorial stained glass window from 1895 and fully operational pipe organ from 1905.  



D. Crop King – Take a tour through the hydroponic vegetable greenhouses, and sample tastings of fresh vegetables.  

E. Whistle Hollow Farm - The Winson family farm has all of your fall decorating needs. Stop by for pumpkins, and enjoy a corn maze and hayrides.  

F. Amish Farm Roads and Schools - *DRIVE BY ONLY* - Get a glimpse of Medina County's Amish community along this scenic stretch of country roads in Homerville and Spencer.
