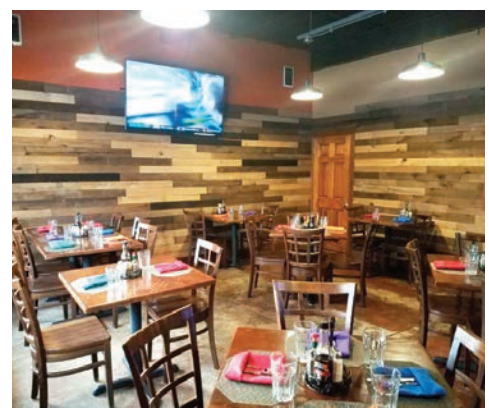

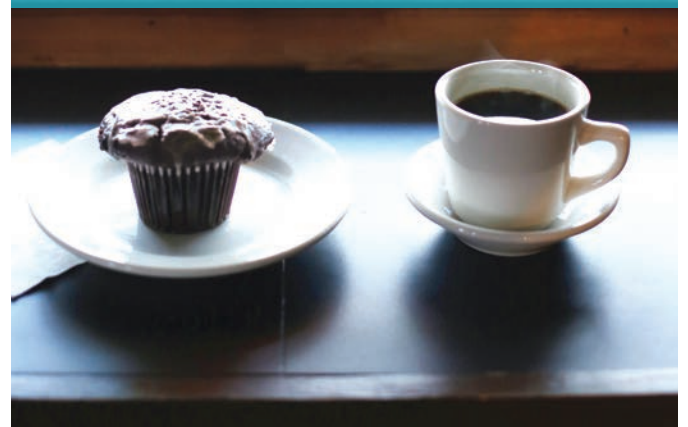

FAMILY TREE

BARB RICCIARDI
CO-OWNER,
RICCIARDI'S TREE FARM

Barb Ricciardi's Christmas tree farm is more than just a destination for festive cheer — though they really excel at all things holidays. Thanks to its two-story barn, the 34-acre farm also serves as a picture-perfect wedding venue.



LET IT GROW: When Ricciardi purchased the Wadsworth Christmas tree farm in 1984, she worried the location was too remote. But as Medina County has grown over several decades, so has the farm. "As soon as we purchased it, that was the boom of Wadsworth," Ricciardi recalls. "It just kind of grew after that, but it still has a rural feel."

HOLIDAY CHEER: "For a lot of families, it's a tradition to come here," Ricciardi says. "We see a lot of the same people year in and year out."

KNOTS LANDING: Ricciardi says she's still shocked so many people actively search for tree farms as a wedding venue, but her farm hosts about a wedding per weekend, highlighted by a wide-open barn for receptions and, of course, all those trees as a picturesque backdrop. "We enjoy interacting with the wedding parties," she says. "They love the place, and we love the place. It tickles us that they want to get married here."

FUN FACT: Selling Christmas trees runs in the Ricciardi family's blood. Before there was a tree farm, the Ricciardis operated tree lots in Wadsworth and Akron dating back to the early 1950s.

BARB AND PERRY RICCIARDI, RICCIARDI'S TREE FARM, JONATHAN MARTIN, GALAXY RESTAURANT DISH, KIM STAHNKE

HOME COOKIN'

JONATHAN MARTIN
EXECUTIVE CHEF,
GALAXY RESTAURANT

Jonathon Martin's first restaurant experience was as a 15-year-old dishwasher at Seville's former Montville Inn. Now 31, he's at the helm of Wadsworth's Galaxy Restaurant, which includes Circle L Steakhouse, Wine Room and Sports Bar & Patio, as its executive chef.



HOME AGAIN: Everything was coming up aces for Jonathon Martin during his 11 years in high-profile kitchens along the Las Vegas strip. But he never stopped missing his boyhood home of Medina County, which is why he jumped at the chance

to join Galaxy last year. "It was almost like the stars aligned," he says.

FINE DINING: Martin isn't looking to reinvent the already popular wheel at the Galaxy. But in a county with just a handful of tried-and-true fine dining spots, he does hope to refine some palates with dishes like his luxurious beef Carpaccio served with truffle, quail eggs and shaved Parmesan. "I want to introduce some things that aren't so common in this area," he says.

A TASTE SENSATION: Martin had modest expectations the first time he whipped up his shrimp and scallop ceviche at the Galaxy, but he was pleasantly surprised by the reaction. "The very first night we did it I had to tell people we didn't have any left," Martin says. "The following weekend, the same thing happened." Now, he says, the entire region seems to be addicted to the dish.

HEE-HAW!

TRISTAN, SHAWN & EILEEN THORSELL OWNERS, BUCKIN' OHIO

If rodeos aren't your thing, they will be after a trip to Buckin' Ohio. That's owner Eileen Thorsell's goal anyway. The 100-acre Burbank ranch gives spectators a genuine cowboy experience with five rodeo shows each summer, bull riding schools, year-round events and the Vintage Barn for private events.



RIDE OF THEIR LIFE: Eileen's son Shawn inspired her and her late husband to open Buckin' Ohio. While Shawn's friends were playing sports, he was riding bulls. It was a passion he developed on a trip to Oklahoma as a preteen, and he was riding professionally by his 20s. "Bull riding is a sport like none other," says Shawn, now 45. "There's the adrenaline rush of knowing that every time you nod your head on a bull, you are in for the ride of your life."

THE FAMILY THAT RIDES TOGETHER: Now Shawn's 17-year-old son Tristan is riding bulls. "We let Tristan ride at our shows," says Eileen, an ever-protective grandmother. "But we select the bull he rides. Normally there's a draw — you can't pick your bull."

ONE OF A KIND: As far as Eileen knows, there's nothing else quite like Buckin' Ohio in the state. "People can go to a bull-riding event in an arena anywhere," she says. "In Cleveland they can go to Quicken Loans Arena. But to come to one that's actually on a working cattle ranch, that's what makes us unique. My husband would say, 'This ain't no punkin roller,' meaning it's the real deal."

ADORING ACCOLADES: The Southern Extreme Bull Riding Association has named Buckin' Ohio rodeos as its Event of the Year twice.

PICTURED: The need for adrenaline runs deep in the Thorsell family. Three generations and numerous awards prove this fact, as former pro-rider Shawn passes the ropes to his son, Tristan, and runs the business with his mom Eileen.

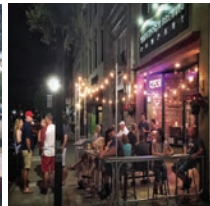

BUSINESS & SCENTS

BRAD ROOT
PRESIDENT, A.I. ROOT CO.

Brad Root takes his role as president of A.I. Root Co. very seriously — and with good reason. The 59-year-old is the fifth generation of his family to run the company, which was founded in Medina in 1869 and is famous for its Root Candles that come in dozens of lavish scents such as chocolate chiffon and rose petals.



BEHIND THE BRICK: Visitors to Medina are often struck by the historic redbrick building on 623 W. Liberty St., built in 1878 for A.I. Root Co. They're downright surprised when they discover a 22,000-sq.-ft. retail shop that sells all things candles. "I've heard over the years that it's one of the best-kept secrets in Medina County that there's a humungous retail store behind all that brick," Root says. "It's quite something to see that old building with all its charm, yet with modern-day products inside."

MEDINA PROUD: Root Candles are sold throughout the country, and while consultants have told Root that it might be better for business to move parts of the company elsewhere, he's rooted to Medina. "Because we were such an early part of the community, it's natural for us to remain here," he says.

BEE'S KNEES: Root's great-great-great-grandfather founded the company as a beekeeping business. "Our brand of honey was called Airline Honey," he says. "It was in Pullman railroad cars. It had good national recognition." The recognition led to Medina's early 20th century nickname: The Sweetest Town on Earth.

WAX NOSTALGIC: A.I. Root Co. is honoring its 150th anniversary in 2019 with various celebrations throughout the year.

LITCHFIELD GAZEBO EST. 1989

Circle Park • Don't miss the Ohio Historical Marker next to the sloped light brown roof of this gazebo in the center of town. The marker is dedicated to the Litchfield Town Band, which was formed around 1900 and still plays on Memorial Day and other commemorations and celebrations.



SPENCER GAZEBO EST. 2002

JB Firestone Memorial Park • The dark brown wooden gazebo is in the middle of a sprawling park less than a mile from the town center. While it's home to a number of community events, it's also the perfect spot to relax after taking advantage of the park's baseball diamonds and basketball and tennis courts.



While you're here:
Head to Pine Crest Farms about a 10-minute drive from JB Firestone Memorial Park to find a petting zoo and seasonal fun such as a corn maze and hayrides.



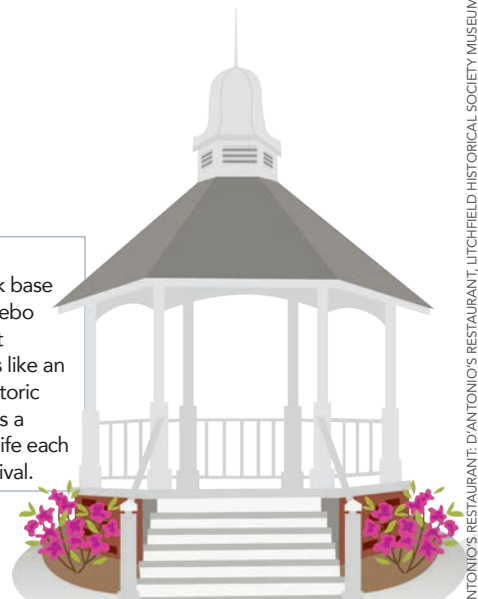
While you're here:

LODI GAZEBO EST. 1987

Lodi Public Square • The red brick base of this simple but significant gazebo in the heart of Lodi — the oldest settlement in the county — feels like an extension of the surrounding historic buildings. The gazebo, which has a unique rounded base, comes to life each July during the Sweet Corn Festival.

MEDINA GAZEBO EST. 1974

Medina Public Square • This architectural standout's intricate features seem to come to life each winter as it's adorned with festive décor and the town's Christmas tree, but it's also a must-visit during warmer months when it serves as a venue for weddings and as the home base of the Medina Community Band.



While you're here: Experience the complex-yet-comforting flavors at Thyme2, which balances the feel of fine dining and local pub.



While you're here: Admire a bustling Medina morning with a cup of coffee and inventive donuts from Circles on the Square Donut Shop, mere steps from the gazebo.

SHARON CENTER GAZEBO EST. 2017

Sharon Center Public Square • The new 18-foot-wide octagon gazebo in the heart of Sharon Center replaced a 36-year-old structure two years ago. But the all-white vinyl gazebo still serves as a popular spot for summer concerts, weddings and events.



While you're here: Head north from Sharon Center's gazebo to find Wolf Creek Environmental Center, which offers hiking, cross-country skiing and hands-on nature programs.



SEVILLE GAZEBO EST. 1991

Maria Stanhope Park • Topped with a horse-shaped weathervane, this gazebo is a short walk from Seville's busy town center. Residents and visitors alike flock to the gazebo for community events such as a summer concert series, 5K runs and more. But its peaceful neighborhood setting makes it the perfect spot for quiet reflection.



While you're here: Dive into the comforting home cooking at American Heritage Restaurant for a slice of small-town charm on a plate.



While you're here: Find vintage and locally made furniture and more at trendy Funky Junk Boutique down the street from the gazebo.



While you're here: Whether you love whiskey, coffee, food or live music, Sonnets Espresso Bar & Restaurant hits all the right notes.



While you're here: Unwind with fresh-popped popcorn at Wadsworth Brewing Co., where the beers are inventive and the atmosphere is down-to-earth.

WADSWORTH GAZEBO EST. 1976

Downtown Wadsworth • Catch the sunset from this westward-facing gazebo for a picturesque evening in Wadsworth's quaint, walkable downtown. The all-white gazebo makes for a popular wedding photo spot and its place in the center of town makes it a popular haunt during events such as the Blue Tip Festival or Fourth of July celebrations.



Battle it out with friends and family in Scene75's laser tag arena, complete with blacklights, thumping music and a maze of walls.

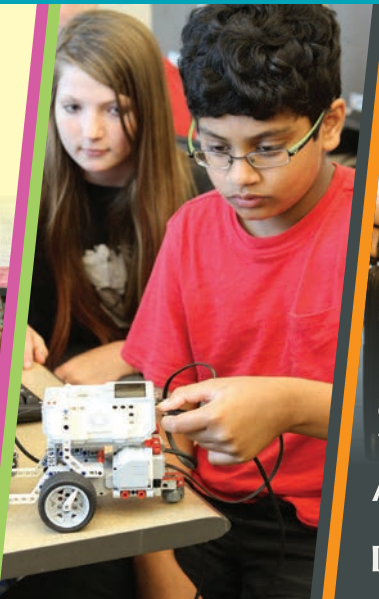

Tom James led the Medina County Park District as its director for 25 of its nearly 54 years, helping it expand from 1,000 to 6,500 acres. With James' retirement in 2018, new director Nathan Eppink has taken the mantle. They both sit down to discuss the parks and more.

Q: Tom, how did you know it was the right time to step away?

TJ: I felt it was time to take time to slow down a little. I will continue to be involved with the Friends of Medina County Parks [where] I currently serve as the secretary and treasurer.

Q: Nate, how does it feel replacing Tom?

NE: You don't replace someone like that. I consider it more like a passing of the torch.

Q: Which parks in the district are among your favorites?

NE: My kids (ages 8, 6 and 3) love the playground at Mugarage Park. The park also has a great little pond, a short asphalt loop trail, a sled hill and more. It also has a fenced-in dog park that attracts visitors from as far away as Cleveland.

TJ: The terrain and forests of Allardale (at left) remind me of the area where I grew up. It was a privilege to work with Stan and Esther Allard, who donated the land to create the park in 1992. Stan and Esther were involved with the planning for the creation of the park and enjoyed seeing people hiking through it.

Q: Tom, what's one of your proudest achievements during your 25 years as director?

TJ: Having the opportunity to preserve open spaces and natural resources. There will always be space for nature.

Q: Nate, how do you want to make your mark on the parks?

NE: There are several parks we want to open in the coming years, and there's a desire to have more multipurpose trails. Also, I want to continue Tom's legacy of preservation. Medina County still has a lot of open space. I enjoy looking at maps and dreaming.

Q: If visitors are looking for an authentic Medina County experience in the parks, where should they head?

NE: You could join a naturalist for a guided hike to learn more about the history of a particular park and the resources we're protecting inside its boundaries. We offer dozens of activities every month, and most are free.
