## DAY 1: ARRIVAL & FOCUSED STRATEGY

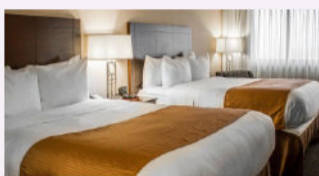
Attendees arrive at a location that feels far away from daily distractions but is still close to major highways and airports. Groups can check in at a conference campus or a business-friendly hotel, such as:



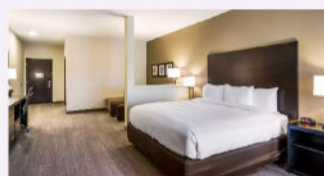
**Hawthorn Extended Stay by Wyndham Seville** (5025 Park Avenue West, Seville) – An all-suite hotel ideal for longer stays, featuring kitchenettes, complimentary breakfast, and flexible gathering space for small groups.



**Holiday Inn Express & Suites Medina by IHG** (5185 Gateway Drive, Medina) – A modern hotel offering comfortable guest rooms, complimentary breakfast, meeting space, and convenient highway access.



**Comfort Inn & Suites** (5 Park Center Drive, Wadsworth) – A reliable and welcoming option with spacious rooms, free breakfast, and easy access to local dining and attractions.



**Comfort Suites Brunswick** (1464 Town Center Boulevard, Brunswick) An inviting hotel with spacious rooms, heated indoor pool, and easy access to local attractions and dining options.

Set aside the afternoon for a focused strategy session in comfortable meeting rooms with access to technology, Wi-Fi, and onsite catering. Breakout rooms are available for executive sessions, team workshops, and group planning. In the evening, groups can plan to have dinner nearby, then relax and network in fireside lounges, or patio areas.

## DAY 2: WORK HARD, PLAY TOGETHER

Day two combines ample work time with opportunities to move, laugh, and think differently together. In the morning, departments or leadership teams can dive into training, planning, and workshops in breakout sessions. In the afternoon, it's time to leave the meeting room for teambuilding activities like:



**High Voltage Indoor Karting** (333 Foundry Street, Medina) – High-energy indoor karting with corporate tournament packages.



**Foundry Social** (333 Foundry Street, Medina) – A lively spot with arcade games, duckpin bowling, bocce, and full dining. It's a great place to mix competition with conversation.



**Market 42** (2099 Pearl Road, Brunswick) – Relax at McGinty's Pub and grab dinner and a few sweets to go along.



**Scene75** (3688 Center Road, Brunswick) – A fun, weatherproof attraction offering a selection of activities all under one roof. Plus, meeting spaces to create your teams "homebase" while having fun.



**Grizzly Pedal Company** (123 Broad #2, Wadsworth) – A 14-seat party bike ideal for customized corporate outings, tastings, and themed tours.



**Dolce at the Strand** (123 Broad, Wadsworth) – A relaxed dessert-and-networking stop with outdoor seating and bocce courts.

After a productive day, groups can relax with a more casual evening. One option is a bonfire and outdoor time at Pocket Park (152 Main Street, Wadsworth), an outdoor area with cozy seating, a mural and 5 firepits, tucked away in Wadsworth's DORA district. Other great choices include:



**Cambria's Bistro** (132 Main Street, Wadsworth) – A dedicated private event space ideal for leadership dinners, client meals, and small presentations.



**17 Public Square** (17 Public Square, Medina) – The Cellar Event Room offers a historic setting with private dining, custom menus, and full bar service for business events and celebrations.



**High & Low Winery** (588 Medina Road, Medina) – Offers private spaces including the High Tasting Room (seats up to 60), Pavilion (seats up to 40), and Turret (seats up to 12) for receptions and small group dinners.



**Corkscrew Saloon** (811 W. Liberty Street, Medina) – an intimate historical and stately dining destination with bar and patio dining off the beaten path.



**Brown Derby** (5050 Eastpointe Drive, Medina) – A classic steak-and-seafood restaurant with private rooms like the Library (seats about 30) and Sunroom (seats about 50) for corporate dinners and celebrations.

For downtown dining, restaurants like **Thyme2** (113 W. Smith Road, Medina) and **The Farmer's Table** (320 S. Court Street, Medina) have delicious menus and a welcoming feel. Groups wanting more energy and entertainment can head to **Alien Vacation Mini Golf Attraction** (260 S. Court Street, Medina) – A fun indoor mini-golf experience suited for friendly team competitions or casual group play.

## DAY 3: WRAP-UP & EXPLORE

A half-day session and farewell brunch give everyone time to plan next steps before leaving in the early afternoon. For spouses, partners, or anyone staying longer, there's plenty to explore:



**Medina County Parks District** (Medina County) – Over 900 acres of beautiful parks, nature preserves and wildlife sanctuaries with hiking trails, playgrounds and all the outdoor activities you can imagine.



**Castle Noel** (260 S. Court Street, Medina) – America's largest year-round indoor Christmas attraction featuring iconic holiday movie displays.
